Gwenn Murray, author of the Report *A Duty of Care to Children and Young People in Western Australia*, has endorsed the Implementation Strategy recently sent to the Minister, The Hon David Templeman for approval.

“I was heartened by the level of commitment of the Director General and the Implementation Committee and I commend the Committee and departmental officers on the development of a strong and evidence-based Implementation Strategy,” Gwenn said.

“This will progress the recommendations into policy and action with a focus on achieving better outcomes for children and young people in care.”

Gwenn has liaised regularly with the Committee since early February and has been advising and supporting the work of the Committee.

They have worked closely together to analyse the Department’s current policies and practices and develop a Strategy and Action Plan to address all 43 recommendations in Gwenn’s report.

Gwenn recently came to Perth and met with Committee members and had roundtable discussions with departmental officers.
