In Australia, **Equal Pay Day 2009** will take place on **1 September**. This date illustrates the number of extra days many women have to work after the end of the financial year to earn the same as men — because **women on average earn 17.2 percent less than men**.

Using average weekly ordinary time earnings...

Men	⊖	\$1262.90
Women	⊖	\$1046.00
Pay Gap	⊖	\$216.90¹

Women are two and half times more likely to live in poverty in their old age than men — by 2019, on average, women will have half the amount of superannuation that men have.²
