



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE PARENTING WA LIBRARY

- ❖ The library is a free service provided through the Department for Communities and operated from Parenting WA.
- ❖ You need to be a member to use the Library. You can get a membership form from the website at www.parenting.wa.gov.au or telephone the Parenting WA Library on 6279 1223 (Metro) or 1800 686 155 (STD Freecall).
- ❖ Library loans can be requested by phone or e-mail. Items will be posted to you within two (2) working days of your request being received.
- ❖ If the item(s) you wish to borrow is unavailable at the time, your name will be placed on a waitlist and will be posted to you when available.
- ❖ Members can borrow up to two (2) items for a period of three weeks (21 days). This includes the time for postal delivery.
- ❖ A reply paid envelope will be included in each package. You can use this to post all items back to us by the due date.
- ❖ Please contact Parenting WA if you are unable to return items by the due date. If other people are not waiting to borrow the item(s), your loan period may be extended.
